3. Read 1 Chronicles 16:8-36.
4. What is the context of this passage (see vv. 1-7.)? You may also want to skim earlier chapters to understand the big events leading up to this worship service)?
5. In vv. 8-36, what past actions of God do the people remember?
6. In vv. 8-36, what fulfilled promises of God do the people remember?

7. In vv. 8-36, what attributes or names of God do you observe? For each one, why is this one important to the flow of the passage?
8. What do we learn about glory from each of the following verses?
 - v. 10
 - vv. 23-27
 - vv. 28-29
 - vv. 35
9. If you were to allow vv. 28-30 to inform and improve your corporate worship experience, what would you do:
 - Before you arrive at church
 - While you are at church
 - After you leave church
10. Why is it true that worship is the natural response to experiencing the glory of God?
11. What one thing will you do differently to allow the glory of God to transform your worship of Him?
