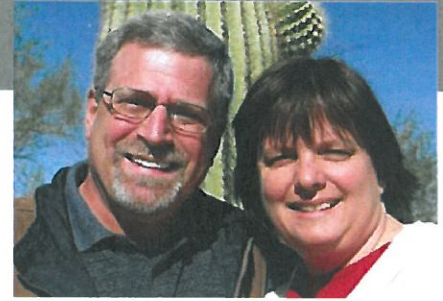

Praises

1. Global CHE Network (www.chenetwork.org) will partner with Healthcare Christian Fellowship International to mobilize 100,000 churches and 1,000,000 witnesses for outreach to their communities through church health ministries.
2. The first 100 bed nets in Togo have been distributed. Fourteen people have professed faith in Christ, and three new home Bible Studies have been established.
3. As a result of a recent trip to Manila, Community Health Evangelism (CHE) partnerships are being formed with the Conservative Baptist Association of the Philippines and Christ Jesus our Lord Fellowship. Plans are being made for me to return in the spring to train master trainers for these two denominations.
4. I met with the new director of the Philippine Mission Mobilization Movement (PM3), a project which I helped initiate back in 1994. He reports that more than 50,000 Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs) have already been mobilized as tentmaking missionaries. Their goal is to mobilize 1,000,000 by 2020.
5. The International Christian Medical and Dental Association and Nurses Christian Fellowship have joined with Healthcare Christian Fellowship International to work toward the launch of a Global Health Care Sunday. The goal of the project is to equip and mobilize evangelical churches worldwide for integrated health ministries that will benefit their communities and spread the Gospel. Initial planning includes work in nine different languages, covering two-thirds of the world's population.
6. Thank God for his financial provision enabling Terry to continue in the work he is doing. Praise God for a new church partner committing regular support to the work.

Prayer Requests

1. Pray for guidance as we move forward with Healthcare Christian Fellowship. Pray the project will result in the mobilization of thousands of churches and hundreds of thousands of witnesses in communities all around the world.
2. One in thirty children in Togo, West Africa, dies of malaria before the age of five. Churches in the city of Lome are equipping their members to deliver bed nets, health education, and the transforming truths of the Gospel into every home in Lome. Continue to pray for the churches committed to this project as they seek to kick the malaria giant out of their city and disciple 2000 new believers in 200 small groups.
