



We will be spending the 2011-2012 school year in the States, based in Littleton, CO.

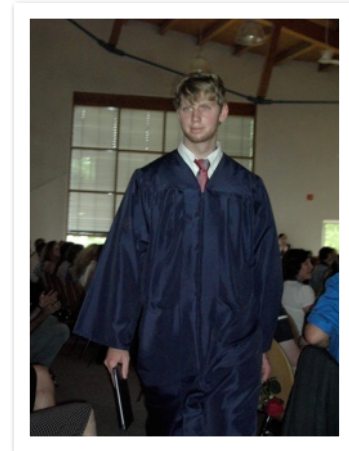
Mark will be a freshman at CSU in Fort Collins, CO. Angel will be in 10th grade and Niki will be in 7th.
