Janet and I really appreciate you, more than words can say. We know you have been affected by this economy just like everyone else, but your faithfulness in our lives has been amazing. We're in the middle of a very busy travel month. I traveled to the Catalyst Conference in Atlanta, Georgia. During the conference I met with several church planters as well as leaders from around the country and particularly Arizona.

I followed the next week by traveling up to Denver with Janet for her evaluation regarding possible additional surgery, this time on her left lung. We have good news. Even though her tests reveal that her MAC disease is still extensive, no further surgery is needed for now. We'll evaluate again in three to six months. Thank you for your prayers!! During the Denver trip, I had the privilege of speaking at the annual board meeting for Missions Door.

On Oct. 24, I will be leaving for Kolkata, India for two weeks, exploring the possibility of church planting in that city. We have a very unique connection with a Christian School called Hope Academy which could be a catalyst spawning multiple churches throughout the region. While in Kolkata, I will be joined by Missions Door President Rick Miller, Vice-President of Ministries Mark Baker, Ministry Director Aaron Palmatier, and missionary Patrick O'Connor. You may be asking, "What are you doing in India?" We are simply exploring the possibilities that God could be opening the door of several ministry and church-planting opportunities. In addition to Hope Academy, I will be meeting with the pastor of Carey Baptist Church and Seminary, exploring partnership possibilities. Please pray for safety and fruitfulness as we look to the future.

We have been diligent in seeking church-planting specialists in additional regions across the United States. Please pray with us as we look at Northern California and the northeast region of the United States.

Lastly, we are anticipating a great church-planting training event in April 2011. We hope to have between 20-25 church planters and/or leaders attend the conference in Orlando, Florida.
